Download New Destination Aggieland App for Gameday Transportation Information

Don't get stuck fighting gameday traffic. Check out the new and improved Destination Aggieland app for the latest parking information, bus and shuttle routes and more! The app highlights all of the pre- and post-game strategies for moving fans, including tailgaters, to and from the Texas A&M University campus provided by the transportation plan, and now can be used year-round for getting to and from campus for other major sporting and university events, such as basketball and

baseball games, Aggie Muster, Graduation, Ring Day and Parents' Weekend.

Travelers can plan their arrivals and departures based on where they are parking and/or where they are going after the game. The free app includes maps, traffic and parking information, shuttle bus routes, gameday events and a robust guide to local dining and entertainment venues. And for up-to-the-minute parking and traffic updates on gamedays follow on Twitter at @GetToAggieGame.

The Destination Aggieland app is free in the Apple App Store and on Google Play, and available for download at gameday.12thMan.com or through the university's iPhone app, TAMUmobile at the Gameday link.
